





Coming Attractions

I have started planning hymns for the season after Pentecost. This is a great time to be able to sing your favorite hymns – whether from the Episcopal tradition or perhaps another. I welcome your input for hymns that you would like to sing at some time during the summer. There are blue request forms in a basket in the gallery. Please return them to me or to my box in the church office as soon as possible. I will try to incorporate each requested hymn – including trying to track down hymn settings that might not be in the *Hymnal* 1982 - but you may have to hum a few notes to get me on the right track. Hum well enough and I'll find a seat for you in the choir – with Ann C. leaving, we need you.



Choral Evensong – Sunday, May 31, at 4pm. The choir is hard at work to make this a beautiful service. We will be singing an Evening Service by Dr. Richard Shephard, with Preces and Repsonses by Rachel Aarons based on two hymn tunes, and two anthems for Trinity Sunday.

Choir Hiatus - Yes, the time is coming for the choir's summer break. We continue weekly rehearsals until Wednesday, June 3, and vest and sing in the service June 10. There will be no choir on June 14, as everyone will be up at Orkney Springs enjoying the fellowship of the parish weekend at Shrine Mont!

Summer Choir will begin on June 21. You are invited to be part of the SUMMER CHOIR – no vestments, no Wednesday night rehearsals. Just come on Sunday morning at 9:30am and gather in the choir room. We will dust off an old anthem or simply prepare a hymn to be presented at the offertory of that morning's service. Come one Sunday or come every Sunday through the end of July.

We have special music planned for Sunday, June 28. Anne Smith will be playing the flute throughout the 10:15am service.

Yard Sale—A Fun Fundraiser!



July 18 Potomac Nationals Baseball Game ~ with picnic beforehand at the Wallace's.


