We are looking forward to having a youth Sunday in the near future. Stay tuned for more information. I look forward to seeing you all on Sundays!





Choir Notes

Dear Friends,

Jenny knows that it often (most of the time, really) is hard to drag my newsletter article out of me. Writing has always been like that – 99% of my time spent pondering or awaiting an inspiration, and then a few moments of actually putting pen to paper, or fingers to keyboard. It only takes a spark. Wait a second, that's it! The choir and their music have done it again! You may remember it from the choir's epic Shrove Tuesday Talent Show performance of hymns for occupations. "The Gossips' Hymn" – you know the one:



It only takes a spark To get a fire going ...

You spread ... to ev'ryone You want to pass it on

The whole performance really made me think, though, not of any one profession or any one hymn, but of the great traditions we share with Christianity in the hymns we sing. (And singing the Psalms unites us even more fully with the worshipping world.)

I am further reminded of our commonality of worship when I visit other churches and speak with musician friends in other places. It struck me anew the other night when I was at a choral rehearsal in Middleburg – I noticed the hymn board postings for the next Sunday's service and recognized several hymns that were the same as we would be using. It struck me again last night when I learned that another church choir would be singing the same arrangement of the same anthem we will sing on March 6th. That happened the last Sunday in January, but for three churches that I knew. Is it because our hymnody and anthems are prescribed, you ask? I suggest that it is not – these observations are across denominations, in big and small congregations, and in varying liturgical traditions. What I believe it illustrates is the power and importance of music to share among ourselves and the world our worship and devotion to God. So when the choir sings *Deep River* that first Sunday in March, perhaps you can imagine the Christians in other rooms across the world in that day, and in that time as well as times before and times to come, who will share in worship.

Back to that spark – maybe it's not just the spark for a newsletter article. Maybe it's a hint of the new fires to be kindled at the first service of Easter late this month. Maybe it's a harbinger of sharing our faith with the world outside our parish doors.

Cantate Domino. Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things.
